Eligible Breeds

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Basenji, Borzoi, Cirneco dell-Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Magyar Agar, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, and Silken Windhounds may be entered.

Method of Release

Other Breeds will be boxed, **EXCEPT that** (1) breeds too large to fit comfortably in the boxes will be hand slipped, and (2) other breeds may be hand slipped upon unanimous agreement of the owner/agents of the hounds entered in that breed on the day of the race. Agreements to hand slip should be reported to the Race Secretary before the hounds of that breed leave the Paddock for the first race of the day.

Lure Type – Drag lure

Distance – 270 yards

Programs – 3 programs for Other Breeds

First Time Entries

First time entered hounds can be registered on the day of the meet by submitting a copy of the hound's registration papers (AKC, NGA, UKC acceptable foreign registry, or ILP *(for all breeds except whippets)*) with a check for \$2.00. Or registration can also be accomplished by sending that same information directly to NOTRA a minimum of 3 weeks prior to the meet. Registration is for the life of the hound. *Official NOTRA rules can be found at www.notra.org.*

A CERTIFICATION RUN MAY BE REQUIRED FOR FIRST TIME ENTRIES, check with the Race Secretary.

DIRECTIONS TO KING’S RANCH

From Red Roof Inn in Plymouth - Take I-494 NORTH for 5.4 miles to I-94 (Exit #27/St Cloud). Follow I-94 for 9.1 miles to Exit #207 for MN State Hwy 101 Rogers/Elk River. Take MN State Hwy 101 NORTH towards Elk River for 7.0 miles. Hwy 101 ends. Take US Hwy 169 NORTH for 1 mile. Turn RIGHT on County Road 12 (EAST)/181st Ave NW for about 2.8 miles. **NOTE: County road number changes to County Road 22 after 2.2 miles.** Turn RIGHT at the 4-way stop onto Baugh St NW (County Road 83). After about 1 mile turn RIGHT on 173rd Ave NW and immediately turn LEFT. King’s Ranch is on your LEFT. Use the second driveway. Distance 27.2 miles, 33 minutes.

From the South, Southeast and Southwest following US Highway 10 Northbound

US 10 (when you get to Main Street in Anoka on US 169, continue to go straight across Main Street. You will be on Ferry Street for about 4 blocks until you are at US 10). Turn LEFT on US 10 and go about 4.5 miles. Turn RIGHT on Armstrong Blvd NW/County Road-83 and go about 4.3 miles. Turn LEFT onto 173rd Ave NW and then an immediate LEFT onto Baugh St NW. King’s Ranch is on your LEFT. Use the second driveway.

All hounds entered must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC) (eligible for entry into the Stud Book register), Canadian Kennel Club, or with the National Greyhound Association (NGA), or with any foreign registry recognized by the AKC. For Rare Breeds not recognized by the AKC, or by any foreign registry recognized by the AKC, hounds must be registered with the Federation Cynologique Internationale (FCI) through its affiliated registries world wide (for dogs born in the USA, the Federacion Canofila de Puerto Rico), and/or the AKC Foundation Stock Service. Hounds registered with the AKC under Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or the CKC equivalent (Listing) may also be entered for all breeds except Whippets.
